Academic Programme

Heathfield Summer School provides an excellent EFL ‘General English’ programme with highly trained and experienced EFL managers and teachers. Our Director of Studies leads a fully effective and motivated team, tuned to the needs of each and every student. Lessons are taught by qualified, enthusiastic, inspiring and most importantly, committed teachers.

Multicultural classes

Students enjoy multicultural classes with a 20-25% language cap on student enrolments to ensure a diverse and dynamic student community.

Curriculum

The curriculum is designed for students to get the most out of their English lessons, to provide a cohesive structure of study, and so that all students get the same experience from their stay in Heathfield. The curriculum is based on the following goals for our students. We aim for our students to:

- 1) **Learn** as much about Britain as they can during their time here.

2) **Develop** the language skills necessary to negotiate situations and problems in English during their stay.
- 3) **Improve** the English they already have and improve their language proficiency.

4) **Build their confidence**, not only as speakers of English, but as young people.

Placement Testing

Once registered for the course, students undertake an online placement test. They also take a short placement test the day after their arrival, ensuring they’ve had enough rest from their travel day. Students are then placed into appropriate classes according to their level and age, following the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).

Students attending Heathfield need to have a minimum of A1 Elementary level. We do not currently take beginners.

Immerse yourself

English Plus+ Academy

Topics covered include Linguistics, Creative Writing, Poetry and Public Speaking and Presenting.

Our English Plus+ Academy is held every Tuesday and Wednesday for up to 3 hours each week. 2 x 1.5 hour sessions. This Academy has one to two teachers per 12 students. For our English Plus+ Academy, a minimum English level of B1 (intermediate) is required and is aimed at our senior girls of 13 +. Students who are deemed not to be at the correct English level having initially signed up for an English Plus+ Academy, will join our Multi Activities Academy. English Plus+ is held every week starting from week 2.

English Plus+ focus includes:

English Plus+ Creative Writing

Poetry

Verse and rhythmic writing with imagery that creates emotional responses.

Biography/Autobiography

Narrative of a person's life, a true story about a real person.

Critical Essay

A short literary composition that reflects the author's outlook or point.

Narrative Nonfiction

Factual information presented in a format which tells a story.

Nonfiction/Reporting

Informational text dealing with an actual, real-life subject.

Speech

Public address or discourse.

English Plus+ Public Speaking and Presenting

Learn how to develop methods in structure and style of speaking and presenting. Build confidence and understand how to engage an audience.

In English Plus+ students have access to key facilities and will be able to build on their own experiences in this increasingly important and versatile skill.

English Plus+ Linguistics

Sounds

How we produce and hear speech sounds, what tools we can use to study them and why that might be important.

Words and Grammar

How do we decide what words mean? Where do dictionaries come from and what are they useful for? How do we keep track of how meanings change over time?

Language in context

Focuses on how language changes depending on when and where we use it.

Drama

Stories composed in verse or prose, usually for theatrical performance, where conflicts and emotion are expressed through dialogue and action.

Sport Academies

Tennis Academy

Available week 1, 3 and 5 x 1.5 hours (£175)

Our professional coaching sessions are managed by former GB Davis Cup player Danny Sapsford. All coaches are LTA accredited. All sessions are designed for small groups (no more than 4 players) of similar standards to gain maximum benefit. Players receive a comprehensive coaching programme including technical, and tactical sessions suitable for all ages and abilities.

Water Sports Academy - Kayaking and Paddleboarding

Week 2 – 2 x 1.5 hours (£125)

Sessions are held at our local 'Horseshoe Lakes'. Students take on the extremely popular sports of Paddle boarding (SUP) and Kayaking, receiving a full safety briefing, skills instructions and most importantly the opportunity to have a lot of fun! All kit will be provided.

Horse Riding Academy

Available week 2, 3, 4 and 5 – 3 x 1 hour sessions (£250)

Session 1: Will be assessment of the rider's ability for the complete beginners. They will learn to mount, dismount, stop and steer and possibly attempt a trot depending on their confidence. The more capable riders once assessed will then progress their riding ensuring correct position and correct use of the aids body and balance.

Session 2: Complete beginners' refreshment as above, and working on pole work, sitting trot and possible attempt at rising trot. Session two for competent riders working on control of the horse in walk, trot and possibly canter using correct school figures, introduction of jump position if showing established seat.

Session 3: Complete beginners' refreshment as of above, working on rising trot and steering around the arena and some school figures, possibly in trot. Third session for more competent riders to work on cavaletti small fences and canter work.

Our instructors work on classic position and control and will not allow a rider to progress to the next stage unless showing correct position, balance and confidence. We will endeavour to progress and stretch all the riders as individuals.

Horse Riding and Stable Management Academy

Available week 1 and week 2 – 3 x 2 hour sessions (£300)

Stable Management: This will cover subject and practical sessions every day from grooming your horse, tack cleaning and fitting of equipment to rugs and fittings for different times of the year. A real insight in to how stable management is so vital when caring and maintaining horses, for them to be in the best condition possible.

Riding Sessions: These follow a similar pattern to the sessions in our Riding Academy with a progression to the final day Hack with views of Windsor Castle, common land and bridleways. An opportunity not to be missed!

Accommodation

Three, Comfortable, Cosy, On-Site Boarding Houses.

All boarding houses are fully secure with key card entry as standard. All our boarding houses are well supervised with a ‘House Mother’ in each house and dedicated pastoral staff, who not only assist in the houses but monitor our students throughout the day, ensuring they are continuously looked after.

Main School

Our junior students (8-12/13 yrs) stay in the main school dedicated boarding house. The youngest junior students live in shared dormitories and twin rooms, with the older junior students residing in single rooms. All the rooms have a wash basin as standard. All have shared shower rooms.

Phoenix House

This house is used for our older junior students (12 to 15 yrs). The majority of the rooms are single with some twin rooms also available. All the rooms have a wash basin as standard. All have shared shower rooms.

Wyatt House

Wyatt house is predominantly used by our senior students (14-17 yrs). All the rooms have a wash basin as standard. All have shared shower rooms.

Transfers and how to find us

Arrivals and Departures
