The Personal Project & Participant Evaluation

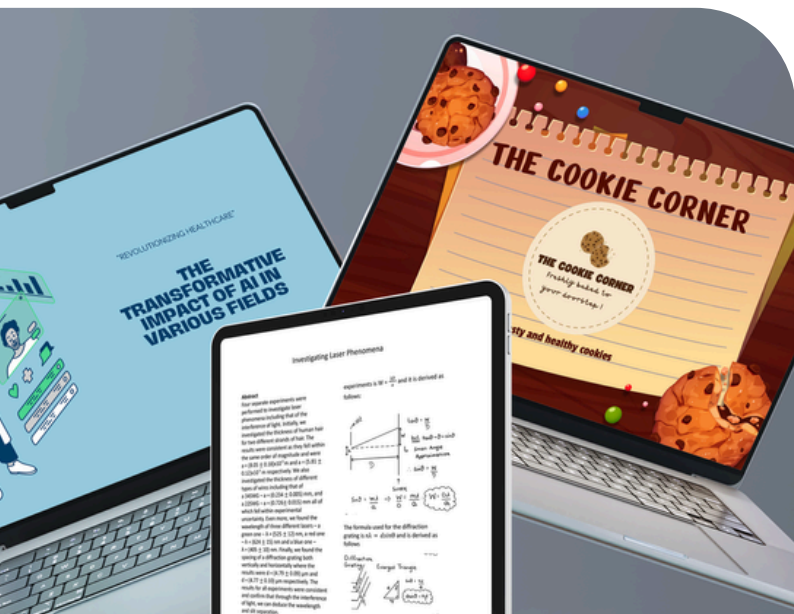

What happens after you apply

Applying successfully for an Immerse Programme is just the first step on your journey with us. We have a robust preparation process in place to ensure a smooth and complete onboarding.

APPLYING AND CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT

Once you have applied online, you will receive a confirmation of application along with payment details. After making your payment, you will need to send us a confirmation email. As soon as your payment has been received, you will receive your Welcome Pack. This will include all the essential information you need, such as details on arrivals and departures, airport transfers, visa guidance, safeguarding, and packing tips to help you prepare.

4 WEEKS BEFORE YOUR PROGRAMME

We will send you your Programme Overview, which will outline your daily timetable, activities, and events so you can start picturing your experience. You will also find out which college you have been allocated to, along with fascinating facts and history about the venue that will be your home during your stay. This is the first step in your pre-arrival information and will help you feel prepared and excited for what lies ahead.

PROGRAMME SYLLABUS

In the lead up to your programme start date, you will receive your Syllabus Guide. This will introduce your tutor, outline the topics you will explore, and share any preparatory materials they have set for you. Reviewing it in advance will help you arrive feeling ready, confident, and eager to make the most of your academic experience.

A FEW DAYS BEFORE YOUR PROGRAMME

You will receive a final email containing links to your Welcome Pack, Programme Overview, and Syllabus, along with the contact details for your College Manager. This is also when you will be invited to join the communications platform, where you can connect with your Mentor Family and receive important updates during your stay.

AT CHECK-IN

Once you have arrived at your college and completed check-in, an email will be sent to your parents or guardians to confirm you have arrived safely. This email will also include a link for them to register their attendance at the graduation ceremony if they are staying locally, which takes place at the end of your programme. You will then be shown to your accommodation and taken on a tour of the college. That evening is all about meeting your mentors and fellow participants, making new friends, and starting to feel part of the Immerse community.

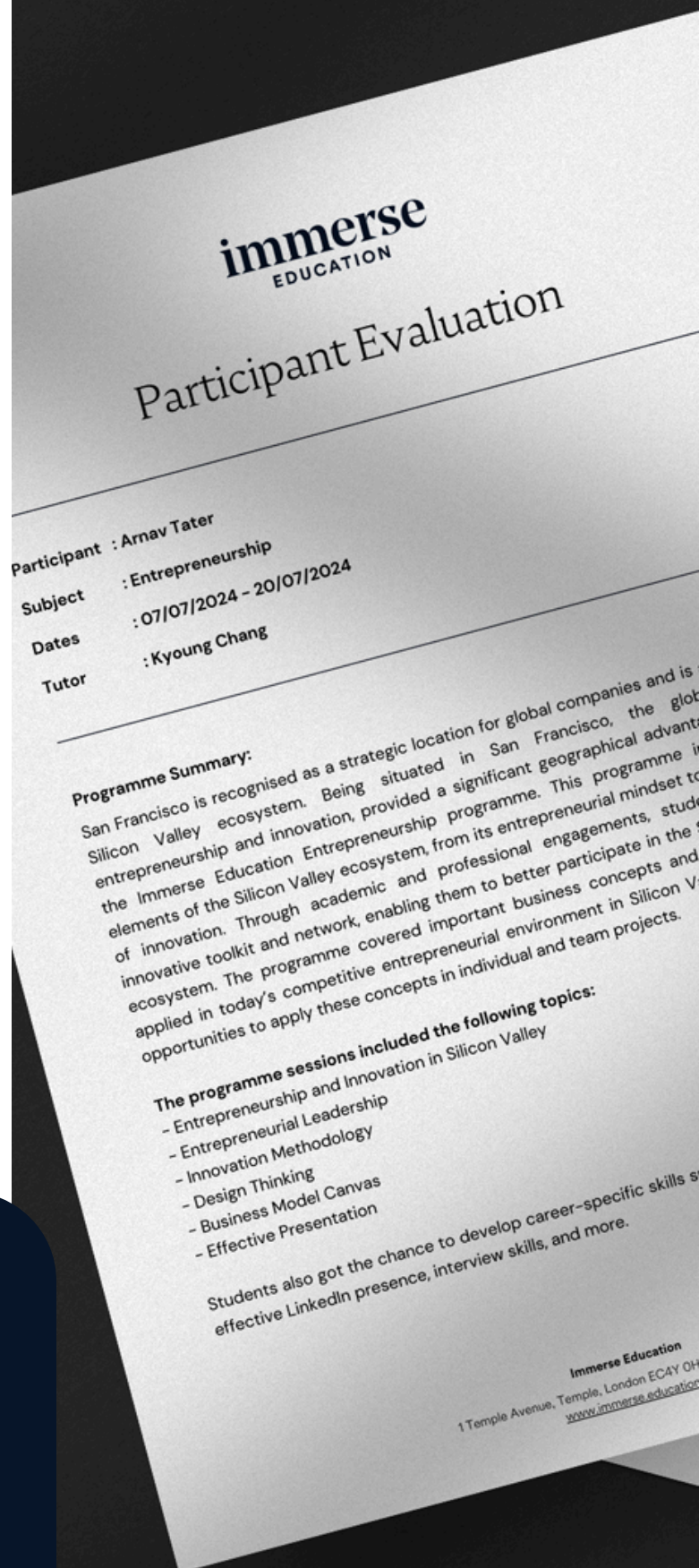
