The Capstone Industry Project is developed and delivered by business education experts. Drawing on your knowledge from the subject studies programme, you will analyse these pitches from a financial perspective, using business terminology and trawling through the business balance sheets! Armed with "virtual money," you will engage in negotiation and bargaining, deciding which ventures to invest in while applying your understanding of financial metrics and business strategies in a realistic and interactive setting.
