This subject introduces international relations as both an academic discipline and a professional practice. Taught by specialists in politics and global affairs, lessons balance theory with applied practice.

Course content may include:

- Political theory and key concepts in international relations
- Globalisation, trade, and interdependence
- International organisations and governance (UN, NATO, EU)
- Human rights and humanitarian intervention
- Security studies and contemporary conflicts
- Diplomacy, negotiation, and conflict resolution
